Rotary to cook for Imagination Library

Anniston Rotary Club will hold its Second Annual Fundraising Event to benefit Imagination Library on Saturday, March 1, at 6 p.m. at Classic on Noble.

The event features two competitions, the Men's Cooking Competition and the Dessert Competition.

In the Men's Cooking Competition, contestants will only be required to prepare an entree, enough for five judges to taste. Any food not used for judging may be shared with the contestant's table companions. The entry fee is \$100 (includes two dinner tickets) and the competition is limited to the first six who sign up.

In the Dessert Competition, contestants will be asked to prepare two identical desserts. One will be sampled first by the judges; attendees will be invited to sample any dessert remaining. The second dessert will be auctioned to raise additional funds. The entry fee is \$50 (includes two dinner tickets) and the competition is open to all Rotarians and guests.
