Since the website was first launched, a number of members have suggested that having a combination of the old directories, where members could learn more about their fellow Rotarians, and a modern online directory with easy-to-access contact information would be greatly appreciated.

The system is now built; all that remains is to gather up-to-date information on everyone. Once that information is filled in, club members will be given a username and password to go to the private portion of the website and view the information. Non-members will not be able to view the information since they will not have a username and password.
