## ***In Memoriam*** **Calvin Wooten**

Anniston Rotary Club - 1972-2012

Calvin Wooten, like his friend and fellow Rotarian, the late Ralph Porch, is remembered as one of the all-time most faithful Rotarians, having a record of seven years of perfect attendance.

Club president Jerry Leake noted in announcing Calvin's death to the club that Calvin had been an inspiration in his service. He praised Calvin for his matter-of-fact handling of his blindness which others might have considered a disability. Jerry also recalled the kindness of another of Calvin's fellow Rotarians, the late J.C. Robinson, who frequently brought Calvin to the meetings and who cut up and identified the food portions on Calvin's plate.

Glen Franklin, a longtime friend of Calvin, remembers him as a faithful example of one who lived the Rotary principles to the fullest and as a member who was dedicated to the club and to all of the club's efforts. "Calvin was just a wonderful individual," Glen said.

Calvin, who joined the club in 1972, will be long remembered for his friendship and service.
