A. This Rotarian was born in Macon, Georgia and graduated from LaGrange College as a business administration major. This person was human resources manager in two Anniston companies - Adelaide Mills and Phelps Dodge Brass (Lee Brass). This Rotarian was one of ten Americans chosen to participate in President Nixon's exchange program with the Soviet Union in 1975 and toured Russia for three weeks. This person served two years as state director for north Alabama for U.S. Senator Donald Stewart. This Rotarian has owned a professional recruiting firm for 30 years.

B. This Rotarian's father was president of our club in 1936. He was a local businessman in the bottling business for RC Cola and Nehi. This Rotarian went to McCallie Military Boarding School in Chattanooga and then to the University of Alabama. Following in his father's footsteps, he has been a member of our Rotary Club since around 1959. He started developing property in Golden Springs before it was an incorporated area. He started the first subdivision there in 1959 and developed there until sometime in the 1980's. He is married and has four children who live in states across the U.S. One daughter is in seminary studying to be an Episcopal priest.

C. In 1970 this Rotarian had dinner with the Queen of England and then danced with Princess Margaret. While on that trip in 1970, he was also on the maiden flight of a Pan Am 747 jumbo jet. In 1978 this Rotarian had a nine-course meal with Robert Mondavi at his vineyard. He says
