## **THE ROTARY GAME**

### ***Who Is This Rotarian?***

#### **WEEK 5**

**A.** This Rotarian carried the 1996 Olympic torch in the relay across the U.S. His first vehicle was a milk truck that he drove to school. He was one of the first medics at the scene of a riot in another state in 1968 where three students were killed. Earlier in life he raised Shetland Ponies and trained them to be ridden by children. His experience includes being thrown numerous times. He climbed Mt. Rainier but did not reach the peak.

**B.** The father of this Rotarian was a Methodist minister. As a child, this Rotarian moved over nine times before the age of 18. This person graduated from Hueytown High School. In college this person became SGA president at Birmingham-Southern College and was in law school with former gubernatorial candidate Bradley Byrne at the University of Alabama.

**C.** This Rotarian is a native of Birmingham. He met his wife standing in line at college — she dropped some papers and he picked them up for her. They've been married for 47 years. He has owned his real estate related company since starting it in Birmingham in 1974. He moved it to Anniston in 1976.

#### **WEEK 6**

**A.** This Rotarian previously owned a restaurant in Oneonta, Alabama. He is an active racquetball player. He was an Army Athlete of the Year during his time in the Army. Prior to that, he was on a National Championship College Team.

**B.** This Rotarian was president of Anniston Rotary Club and so was his father and his grandfather. He is an Eagle Scout. He is a fraternity brother of Bear Bryant. He spent time at UAB and the University of Virginia but graduated from a different university. He helped build a home with President Jimmy Carter.

**C.** This Rotarian was once interviewed by the international press corps 43 times in 8 days. She was the local escort for Finnish archery star Jari Lipponen during the 1966 Olympics. She was previously a member of the Fayetteville, Georgia Noon Rotary Club where she was the first female Rotarian on the south side of Atlanta. She had a trivia question selected and published in the All American version of Trivial Pursuit.
