MEMBERSHIP DUES PAYMENT POLICY

Approved by Board of Directors on 5/7/13

Membership dues for the Anniston Rotary Club are billed in advance at the beginning of each calendar quarter.

Example:

Membership dues for January, February, and March are billed on January 1.

Payment is due within **30 days** of the invoice date and considered past due after 31 days.

Example:

An invoice dated January 1 is due by January 31 and is past due on February 1.

If an invoice is unpaid after **45 days** (15 days past due) a notice letter will be sent providing an additional 15 days to pay the outstanding membership dues.

Example:

An invoice dated January 1 that is unpaid by February 15 will result in a notice letter. The member will have until March 2 to pay the outstanding dues.

If an invoice is unpaid after 60 days (30 days past due) the member will be suspended. A member suspended for failure to pay quarterly dues will need to pay the full outstanding balance before reinstatement.
