Honda tour set for May 27 Deadline to sign up - May 13

Ike Brown has arranged another tour for the club, this time at the Honda plant. The following are details about the tour set for Tuesday, May 27:

- No cameras/video recorders are permitted on the tour.
- No cell phones or PDA's are allowed.
- No handbags, backpacks, briefcases or packages are allowed.
- Minimum age is 12 years old.
- Those touring must wear long pants and closed-toe shoes.
- A list of participants must be received by Honda at least ten business days (May 13) prior to the tour.
- Any requests for special accommodations must be received at least ten business days (May 13) prior to the tour (canes, crutches, walkers are not allowed).
- The tour is about 1-1/4 miles long and takes approximately 1 hour and 20 minutes.
- Meet at the Welcome Center at 11:45 am for lunch which will be followed by the tour at 1:00 pm.
- Ike will have copies of directions to Honda at the May 13 meeting.
