## ShelterBox founder recognized by CNN

Tom Henderson, Rotarian and founder and CEO of disaster relief charity ShelterBox, recently appeared on the CNN *Heroes* series of special reports on people who have an extraordinary impact on the world.

Henderson spotted a gap in aid provision for natural disasters in 1999 and developed the idea of the "ShelterBox" which provides shelter and other essential equipment for survival in an easily transportable box. After gaining support of Rotary Clubs worldwide, ShelterBox was formally launched in 2000 and the first boxes of aid were distributed in 2001. Since that time, ShelterBox has raised over \$40 million and responded to 75 natural and humanitarian disasters.

Major deployments have included Hurricane Katrina, the Pakistan and China earthquakes and the cyclone in Myanmar (Burma). Currently, ShelterBox is responding to severe flooding in Nepal.

Earlier this year, Anniston Rotary Club raised funds for two Shelterboxes which were used to help victims of earthquakes in China.
